

## Land Managers Voluntourism Assessment

### Your Existing Volunteer Program

- Do you have an existing volunteer program?
- Do you have a full or part time volunteer manager?
- Does your manager have sufficient time to oversee programs from contract through completion?
- Do you have a regional volunteer coordinator?
- Do you have an existing volunteer contract (VIP)
- Are your maintenance and interpretation staff members cross-trained in managing/directing volunteers?
- Can you track and value the number of volunteer hours that are contributed?
- Do you recognize and acknowledge volunteers currently?
- Can this be modified for transient volunteers?

### Infrastructure

- Are you familiar with tourism professionals in your area? State? Country?
- Does your geographic location lend itself to voluntourism?
- Are there campsites/dining/accommodation that can support a multiday program?
- Are their site visitations fees that need to be offset?

### Projects

- Do you define large and small scale work projects ahead of time? Yearly? Monthly?
- Can your work projects be broken down into skilled/semi-skilled /basic levels?
- Can your work projects be broken down into weekly and daily chunks?
- Can your work projects be broken down into easily trainable sections?
- Do you have sufficient tools, equipment/protective gear for work groups of 10? 20? 50?
- Is there funding to expand your volunteer program?
