Through education, information, and representation, the Association of Partners for Public Lands (APPL) enhances the potential of its member not-for-profit organizations to provide the highest levels of program and service to public agencies entrusted with the care of America's natural and cultural heritage.

APPL provides training, publications, an annual convention and trade show, and other programs to foster professional management practices among members and the agencies they serve. For more than 25 years APPL has worked to advance the common purposes of its member organizations to work in partnership with those public agencies entrusted with the care of America's parks, monuments, forests, lakes, and refuges.

Full Membership in APPL is offered to not-for-profit organizations operating sales outlets and providing interpretive resources under a formal agreement with any public land management agency. Affiliate Membership is offered to not-for-profit organizations supporting public land agencies in ways other than sales of interpretive materials.

The Vendor Support Program encourages corporate sponsorship of APPL programs. Becoming an APPL Sponsor or Benefactor offers vendors greater visibility and access to customers. It also supports educational programs that help associations and their partner agencies fulfill their public service missions.

Public Lands and Their Not -for-Profit Partners

Many non-profit organizations exist to enrich visitors' experiences at public lands. These organizations, called cooperating, interpretive, or friends organizations - work in partnership with the various agencies to providing a number of benefits and services including:

- Operation of interpretive bookstores
- Development of educational materials
- Publishing of books about natural and historic sites
- Conduct of field institutes and seminars about the geology, archeology, natural and cultural history of the area
- Underwriting of numerous special onsite programs and projects
- Engagement of volunteers
- Fund raising and membership programs

Nearly 80 nonprofit associations operating in more than 600 of our nation's finest natural and cultural areas belong to APPL. These associations are as diverse as the sites they represent. While some serve a single site, many of the larger associations are designed to serve multiple public lands and to operate in areas often too small or remote to sustain an independent association. Through a concept of shared resources, their revenues help support national and regional programs as well as those of individual public lands units.

Although their primary role is to enhance public knowledge and understanding of America's public lands, associations donate substantial support to their agency partners. Proceeds from sales and other association revenues help fund publications; museum, library, and research activities; and other education and conservation efforts.

Our Government Partners

Federal, and some state and local, public land management agencies work in cooperation with nonprofit organizations to provide interpretation and visitor services. Today, there are 64 national park cooperating associations, serving nearly all of the more than 387 areas of the National Park System. The Bureau of Land Management has about 28 cooperating sites. The Forest Service has partnerships with 60 interpretive associations. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has agreements with 24 cooperating associations. Sixty-one associations operate bookstores on national wildlife refuges for the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. In addition, an ever-growing number of organizations serve wildlife refuges and other public lands as friends groups to raise funds, recruit volunteers, and provide other kinds of support.
